



BEFORE CANNES, PREPARE YOUR MARKET

1. Use www.marchedufilm.com ([Useful Information](#))

and online tools created to help you attend the Marché in Cannes:

- to be sure you have asked yourself all the necessary questions
- to be aware of all the services the Marché du Film offers you
- to familiarize yourself with the Marché zones (Marché du Film maps are downloadable)
- to download your visa letter

2. Connect to www.cinando.com*:

- to get updated information concerning companies, people, films and projects registered with the Marché du Film (list of participants, screening schedules...)
- to find their contacts and organize your appointments beforehand
- to maximize the visibility of all your information (company, line ups, contact details...)

The information in Cinando is consulted by other participants and all Cinando users and is also used by the Marché du Film in its printed Guide. As a registered participant at the Marché du Film, you benefit from a one-year complimentary access to Cinando. Download the Cinando application on your iPhone, your Android and your iPad without paying extra fees.

* The login procedure was given to you when your registration was confirmed.

3. Read carefully the Marché du Film newsletters (sent regularly before and during the event):

- to stay informed and updated
- to benefit from all the offers and services

IN CANNES, GET THE MOST OUT OF YOUR STAY

1. Get the most important information

- Consult the [information package](#) given to you when you get your badge:
 - **the Guide***: the reference book all year long for the film industry
 - **the Pocket Guide***: the practical guide, full list of screenings, basic information and synopsis for every film
 - **the Industry Programs and Events***: list of producers and projects by country
 - **the Funds Guide***: an essential list of public funding sources
 - **Focus***: the world market trends
 - **Official Festival Program**: information on the Festival's artistic program, the jury, the films, the events

*: these publications will be available on the Marché du Film website ("My Account").

- Get the [Daily Screening Program](#): the most updated schedule of screenings for the following day, distributed from 4pm at the information desks and in front of all screening rooms
- Use [the trades](#) (daily professional magazines) available at Press Points to inform you about the industry trends, events etc. (entrance to the Riviera, Light Dome, central aisle level -1).

2. Take advantage of the Marché du Film services:

3. **(Re)discover** the films presented at the Marché du Film with the **catch-up screenings** on www.cinando.com.
