# SECURITY: GOOD HABITS TO GET INTO FOR THE FESTIVAL



### Arrive early.

There may be a delay entering the Festival area because of security checks.



**Stay alert and do not leave bags unattended.**



**Report all suspicious behaviour and any unattended bags or luggage to the Festival staff, or call +33 (0)4 92 99 87 77.**



**Do not bring very large bags.** There is a left luggage office available opposite the ferry terminal.



**You will be required to open your bags for checking.**



## ANTI-TERRORIST SECURITY MEASURES ARE IN FORCE

### THE FOLLOWING OBJECTS ARE STRICTLY FORBIDDEN INSIDE THE FESTIVAL AREA:

- Large bags (15 litres+), suitcases
- Firearms and bladed weapons (including replicas)
- All sharp objects, such as knives and scissors
- All aerosols and pressurised bottles (apart from water misters) toxic or chemical products and inflammable liquids
- Fireworks and similar devices, such as firecrackers, flares and distress rockets

### IN ADDITION, THE FOLLOWING OBJECTS ARE STRICTLY FORBIDDEN IN THE THEATERS:

- Opaque containers, such as flasks and cans
- All glass bottles bigger than 100ml
- All plastic bottles which hold more than 500ml
